#### **Job Description**

Under the supervision of the Regulatory Affairs Manager, you will support the launch of our first drug (if approved): Xervyteg®. In a context of evolving regulatory frameworks in our key target markets (Europe and the US), you will actively participate in the implementation of our regulatory compliance strategy.

#### **Your Main Responsibilities**

- Strategic and Regulatory Monitoring
  - Monitor regulatory developments in the field of microbiotherapy in Europe and in the United States, including the validation of the Pharma Package and European texts impacting microbiome-based products;
  - Identify regulatory risks and propose positioning strategies and action plans;
  - Map key stakeholders (authorities, institutions, etc.) relevant to MaaT Pharma's activities.
- Content Writing
  - Draft analysis notes, regulatory briefs, position papers, and informational materials for internal teams, management, partners, and stakeholders;
  - Prepare supporting documents for institutional meetings (ministries, members of parliament, agencies), including background notes and presentation materials;
  - Write position statements in response to public consultations.
- Institutional Relations and Coordination
  - Contribute to the development of an engagement strategy with identified organizations;
  - Support coordination efforts with health authorities, administrative bodies, European working groups, and professional associations such as [MTIG](#) and [EMIH](#);
  - Organize and prepare institutional meetings: coordinate communications and ensure follow-ups, track interactions, and maintain relationships;
